Combine your LIGHT the WORLD acts with study and goals from Personal Progress, Duty to God or Faith in God. Pick and choose which of these suggestions will work for you. Some of the goals and projects will take more than one day, but even so they can enhance your experience with the service you give this month. This information here is meant to be a summary and guide for choosing ways to combine Light the World with goals, but make sure to look in the booklets for the full requirements of each goal or project.

		You could use Good Works 5, 6, or “write your own” with any of the Light the World daily themes. A Good Works value project could be to do something for each of the daily themes and record your thoughts and feelings about becoming like the Savior.	You could create a project 1) in any one of the specific daily themes or 2) by planning to do service each day until Christmas. This could go with “Priesthood Duties” > Serve Others. For Priests: You could serve others using the Light the World themes to learn about how the Savior treated others or you could strengthen a friend by inviting him to work with you in giving service. Either of those ideas could go with “For the Strength of Youth: Family and Friends”	You could 1) Read about the good Samaritan and plan a service project or 2) Plan your own service activity. These two ideas are listed in “Serving Others” and could go with any of the Light the World daily themes.
