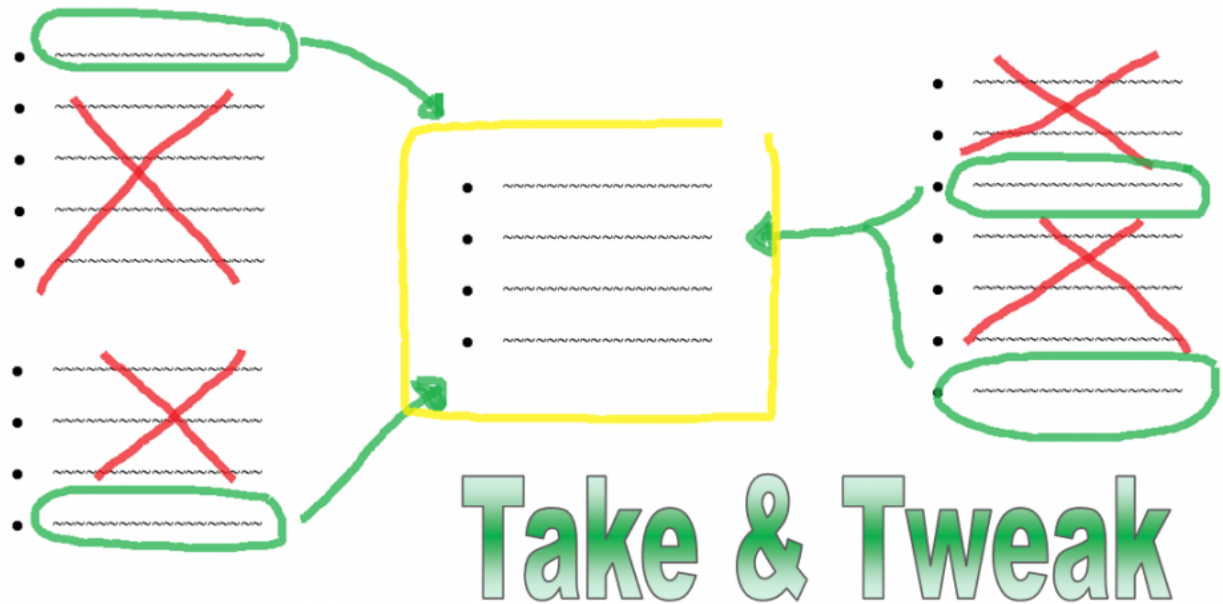


# Take & Tweak
